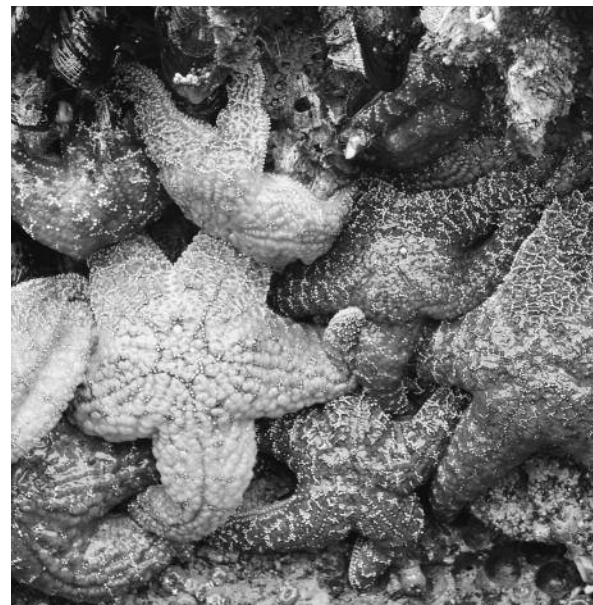
For families of all ages


iRobot

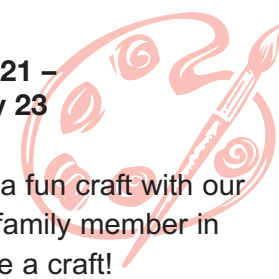

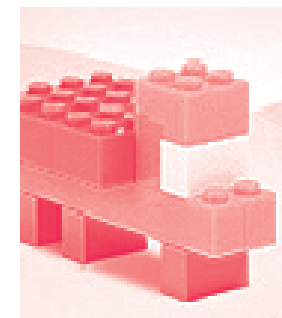

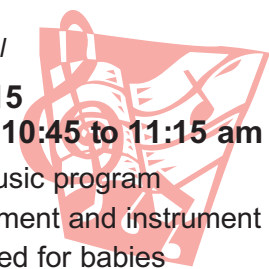
Music Together®
